Qualifications

- B.Arch or M.Arch from an accredited program in the United States or Canada.
- At least a year of experience after graduation specifically in residential wood-framed architecture. Candidates with less experience will be considered if most of the other qualifications listed are met.
- While this is not a design position per se, we consider translating sketches into CAD an integral part of the design process, so the ability to think and design while drafting is crucial. Your design sense will be called upon every day.
- We are a Mac-based office. Experience with the following Macintosh programs as well as Mac OS X would be handy: PowerCADD and SketchUp Pro especially, as well as FileMaker Pro, QuickBooks Pro, Word, Excel, iView Media Pro, InDesign, Illustrator, Lightroom and Photoshop.
